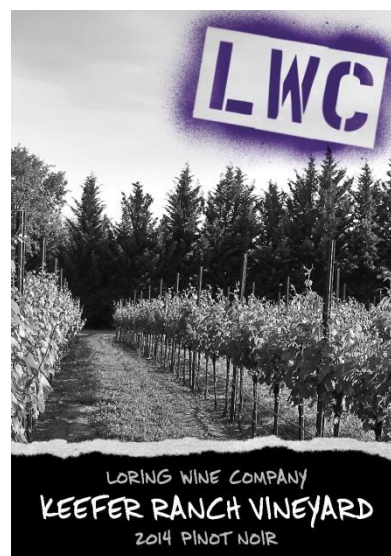




# Loring Wine Company 2014 Keefer Ranch Vineyard Pinot Noir

## Reviews

### **Steve Heimoff**

**93 Points**

The wine feels crisp and balanced. It's juicy in cranberry, strawberry and persimmon fruit, with a nice coating of smoky oak and a long, dry, spicy finish. Drinks well now, and should hold in the bottle over the next six years.

### **Greg Walter (Pinot Report)**

**93 Points**

Medium ruby color; complex, floral, plum and cherry aromas with soft, earthy undertones; layers of spiced plum and cherry flavors and a fine, silky texture; good structure and balance; long finish. Spicy and silky Pinot with nice earthy notes.

### **Jim Laube (Wine Spectator)**

**91 Points**

Combines ripe, generous plum, boysenberry and black cherry flavors with a supple texture, touches of dusty earth and anise, and a long, clean finish.

### **PinotFile - Prince of Pinot**

**91 Points**

Moderately light reddish purple color in the glass. Red fruits drive this wine which is typical of this cool-sited vineyard. Flavors of iced cherry and strawberry are framed by juicy acidity and suave tannins. The

wine's velvety mouthfeel is very seductive. More flavor intensity arrives over time in the glass, including more generosity on the oak infused cherry scented finish.
